

### **Annex 1: *Biography of Dr. Terry Lee***

Terry Lee recently retired from the positions of Vice President and Chief Scientific Officer of E. & J. Gallo Winery, the large family-owned winery based in Modesto, California. At Gallo Terry had responsibility for integrating advances in the science and technology of viticulture, winemaking, packaging and sensory science into the products of the company. Terry chaired the Technical Committee of the California Wine Institute, was a member of the Governor's Pierce's Disease/Glassy-winged Sharpshooter Task Force, participated in other California wine industry affairs, and represented the USA in the forums of the OIV and the World Wine Trade Group.

Before joining Gallo, Terry was the Director of The Australian Wine Research Institute in Adelaide for over 14 years, held the Chair of Oenology in The University of Adelaide, prepared the successful bid for the Cooperative Research Centre for Viticulture in 1991, chaired the organizing committee for five Australian Wine Industry Technical Conferences, and participated widely in the technical affairs of the Australian wine industry. These included the negotiation of the bilateral agreement between the EU and Australia for trade in wine and the forums of the OIV. Terry has been a wine judge with many years of experience in Australia, Canada and New Zealand. He currently is a member of the Board of the Grape and Wine Research and Development Corporation, the major funding body in Australia for grape and wine research, and chairs the Innovation Policy Committee of the Australian grape and wine industry.

Terry holds a BSc and PhD in Food Technology from The University of New South Wales and taught in the School of Food Science and Technology for 12 years.

In 2007 Terry was made a Patron of the Australian industry and was awarded an OAM in the Queen's Birthday Honours List.
